Deadline for submission of proposals: 30 June 2023

At least 6 partners from 6 countries (3 EU & 3 non-EU)

Available budget: €65,691,511

Maximum budget per project: €1.5 million

Project duration: max. 36 months

First Call expected in late April / early May

Programme area:

- ✓ Bosnia and Herzegovina (109 municipalities and Brčko district)
- ✓ Montenegro (Podgorica, Zeta, Tuzi, Cetinje, Danilovgrad, Nikšić, Ulcinj, Bar, Budva, Tivat, Kotor and Herceg Novi)

Partnership requirements: at least 1 from 2 countries (Croatia mandatory)

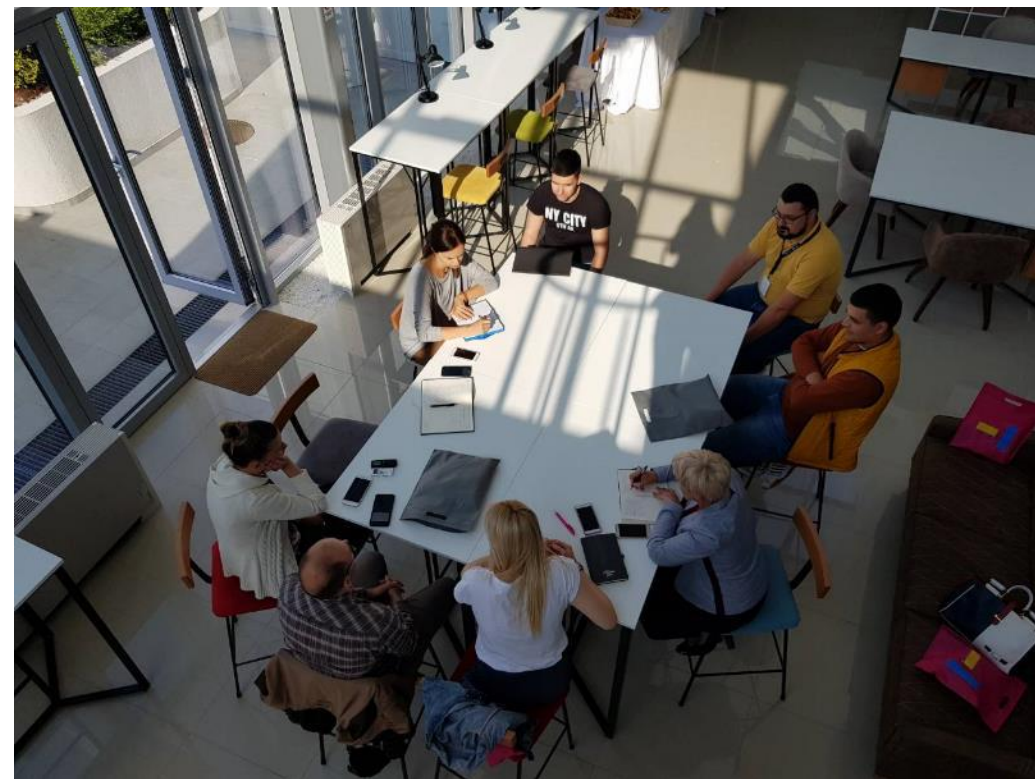
Maximum number of partners: 6

SMART SCHOOLS

Innovative minds for smart schools

Main results:

- 7 schools in Croatia and BIH renovated to improve their energy efficiency
- new biomass boilers installed in 5 schools
- 2 demo solar photovoltaic systems that won an energy saving competition installed in schools
- school solar laboratories equipped
- 19 models/prototypes of IT/technical innovative solutions in the field of renewable energy sources developed as part of a young innovators camp
- reduction of CO2 emissions of 852.93t on an annual basis

Total budget: EUR 1,644,127.82 | EU co-financing: EUR 1,395,864.49
