






Project portfolio

IPA III Programme 2021-2027

On 23.05.2022 the European Commission issued the Commission Implementing Decision on the financing of the IPA III Cross border cooperation programme Kosovo – North Macedonia 2021-2027.

The Union contribution for the IPA III implementing period is **8.4** million Euro

Divided in three allocations for 2023, 2025 and 2027.

Horizontal and cross-cutting issues

Gender mainstreaming and equal opportunities

Gender equality between women and men belongs to the fundamental values of the EU and as such, it is part of the programme strategy.

The design of the indicators **disaggregated by type of organisation (especially women's associations)** or by sex and age for monitoring and evaluation will be further reflected in the eligibility and project selection criteria through call for proposals.

Youth unemployment

Improving labour market participation, especially of young people and women, disadvantaged groups and minorities.

Youth inclusion

One of the priorities of the programme

Monitoring database measures youth participation for every project

□ Highly recommended to Include/benefit youth and woman in project applications

Partnership with other institutions – highly recommended

- Act jointly, create networks of stakeholders
- Local government and other public institutions usually insist on investment project, sometimes they forget on the needs of the youth
- Provide youth perspective and impact to the institutions
- □ Feed with productive and impactful ideas
