WHAT'S IN THERE FOR YOUTH?

Interreg Greece-Albania 2014-2020 covered four regions:

- 1. Korçë, Berat, Vlorë, Gjirokastër
- 2. Implemented 68 projects overall
- 3. Most partners were public authorities
- 4. Direct and indirect impact on youth

It was built on two priority axis:

- 1. The Environment: promotion of environment, sustainable transport and public infrastructure
- 2. The Economy: promoting entrepreneurship and supporting SMEs

Projects developed involving the youth:

- 1. EXPLORAL
- 2. BUSINESS CLUBS
- 3. STONE.ART











In the context of the European Cooperation Day, SASPAC in cooperation with Municipality of Përmet organized an event last September in Përmet, with several activities to increase the visibility and promote the cooperation and the impact of the projects financed under the Interreg IPA-CBC Greece-Albania 2014-2020 Programme in the local area.

As the year 2022 was labelled the European Year of Youth by the European Commission, the participation of youth from both sides of the border were foreseen and included during all the planned activities.

The activities consisted of:

- 1. A visit to the Public Library of Përmet, in the context of the EXPLORAL and Business Clubs Projects
- 2. A visit to the Cultural Center in Përmet, in the context of the STONE.ART
- 3. A public cultural event with the participation of youth and a Fair to promote the local products
- 4. A rafting trip in Vjosa river


























Interreg Greece-Albania 2021-2027 will cover five regions:
