List of reforms

1. Comply with the Digital Identity regulation and implement Digital eWallet for public services
2. Update the framework for cyber resilience by introducing requirements of NIS2 Directive and strengthening relevant institutions
3. Update the framework for a secure and sustainable digital infrastructure
4. Improve enabling environment for innovative businesses and their take up of the potential of the green and digital agenda, including enabling relevant financial support



Expected impact by 2027*

- A grants scheme designed and implemented, focusing on SMEs and start-ups, with 30% of total funds allocated to green and/or digital solutions.
- Verified electronic identities implemented to enable access to digital public administration services, including at least 22 existing e-services on E-Albania in the fields of taxation, social services, and education.
- Digital Wallet for public e-services developed and piloted in line with EU standards, covering at least 10 public e-services as part of the Digital Identity Wallet.
