List of reforms

1. Align with electricity integration package to enable electricity market coupling of the EU and Albania, establish the intraday electricity market, operationalise the package in line with the market coupling operator integration plan by 2025
2. Gradual tariff adjustments to market prices accompanied with measures to address energy poverty
3. Develop transparent and competitive quantity-based action plan for renewable energy: Planning for 3 years in place
4. Implementation of the Renewable Energy Directive: adopt RES legislation, streamline permitting, establish the renewable energy communities, operationalise guarantees of origin
5. Work on carbon pricing with the aim of having an ETS in place by 2030: focus on Monitoring, Reporting, Verification and Accreditation (MRVA) package
6. Adoption and implementation of long-term building renovation strategy, and energy efficiency scheme



Expected impact by 2027*

- A quantity-based auction plan adopted to support the installation of at least 600 MW of new renewable energy capacities over the next three years.
- A long-term building renovation strategy adopted, with earmarked financing for 2025 and 2026 to meet the annual renovation target of 3% for existing public buildings.
- Eco-design regulations for solid fuel local space heaters adopted, and infrastructure and capacity for market surveillance established to ensure effective enforcement.
