List of reforms

1. Revise the VET system to better match the labour skills demand
2. Update of the curricula in primary and secondary education
3. Update the national Qualifications Framework by establishing a clear and transparent relationship between national qualification levels and the relevant European QF levels.
4. Advance digital skills and literacy for youth and ensure the provision of sufficient ICT equipment to public schools and universities.
5. Strengthen the efficiency of the Unemployment Policy Scheme
6. Strengthen the Research and Development national environment by adopting enabling strategic framework



Expected impact by 2027*

- 85% of VET teachers trained on the revised vocational education curricula.
- The share of unemployed jobseekers enrolled in Vocational Training increased to 20% of the total unemployed jobseekers.
- 50% of VET graduates employed in their field of study within 3 to 6 months after graduation.
- 60% of jobseekers registered at employment offices.
- 90% of public and private VET providers undergo the accreditation process
- Smart Labs established in 75% of public schools.
- Implementation of a systematic certification scheme for digital skills programmes, leading to 6,000 certified individuals.
